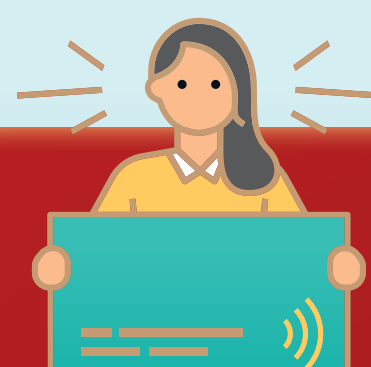
## I'm going abroad!

## >> One Multicurrency Account



**with 9 supported currencies: IDR, CNY, USD, HKD, AUD, SGD, EUR, GBP, dan JPY**

#### Service Features :

Transfer funds for living cost or other personal needs in foreign currencies and avoid transfer fees by opening multicurrency account for you and your child.

## >> Student Remittance Program for Education Fees



**Payment for tuition, dormitory fees, etc.**

#### Service features:

Remitting the tuition fees, etc., in full amount

#### Receiving account:

University/ Institution's account(s) in China

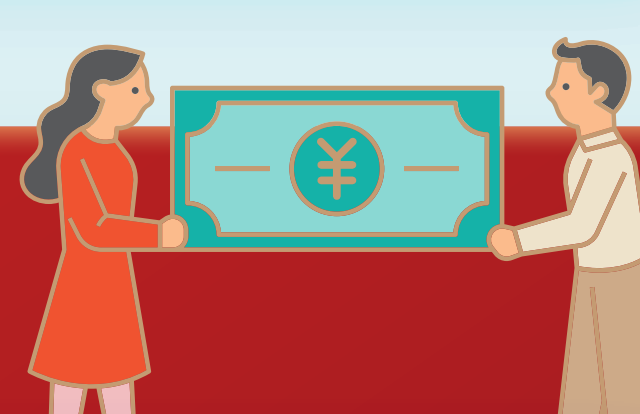
#### Remitting currency:

CNY.

#### Service Channel:

Student or family member (as proxy to manage the student's account) holding Bank of China (Hong Kong) Limited Jakarta Branch account may visit our nearest sub-branch and present the tuition invoice as supporting documents to make a CNY Remittance Transaction

### Payment Services



#### Debit Card

- Pay with UnionPay Dual Currency Debit Card at merchants, or withdraw cash through any ATM with UnionPay network in Mainland China (fee waived for the first withdrawal every month)

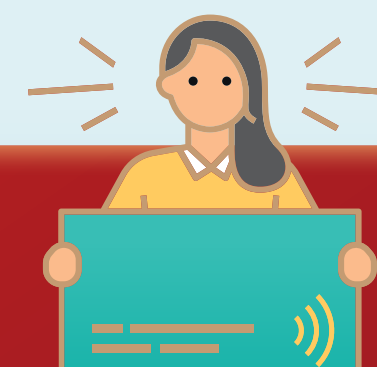


#### WeChat / Alipay

- Bind your UnionPay Dual Currency Debit Card with WeChat Pay or Alipay for convenient payments.<sup>1</sup>

### Required Documents



Visit our nearest Bank of China sub-branches in Indonesia, with your **National ID, Parent's National ID, Parent's Tax Registration Card (NPWP), Family card, Admission Notice/Letter from University, and Power of Attorney** (optional).
